age of 18 must submit a signed declaration of consent from a parent or legal

guardian on the day of the competition.

All starters must declare that they have no physical complaints and are able to perform a high level of physical exertion and can swim. If this is in doubt, the participant must undergo a medical examination and follow the doctor's advice. The declaration form will be completed on site when the entry fee is

paid.

The organizer reserves the right to exclude participants from the event who

obviously do not meet the required health standards.

V1/OC1 relay WK48: Open, 4 x 250 m

In the relay, 4 starters from a club each ride 250 m with a baton. The baton must be handed over to the next rider. The relay team of 4 must consist of at

least one V1.

Classification as German Championship If there are more than 3 starters, the race will be counted as a German Championship. If there are more than 9 starters per race class, preliminary and intermediate heats may be held. The final race consists of a maximum of 9

boats.

Prices Places 1–3 of the final run receive a medal and certificate.

The best German starter in the final race will receive a championship jersey.

Boat classes

V1 Outrigger boat without rudder. The outrigger must be on the left-hand side be

attached.

OC1 and OC2 Outrigger boat with and without steering. The outrigger can be attached on the

right or left side.

V6 Outrigger boat without rudder. The outrigger must be attached on the left-

hand side. For the V6, a minimum weight of 110 kg applies to the main hull

only. The organizer reserves the right to check this on site.

V1, OC1, OC2, V6: All valuation classes, 500 m on lanes
